GENERAL DESCRIPTION

The Dive Supervisor is the on-scene representative of Celtic Sub Sea management, and is directly responsible for the safe and efficient conduct of diving operations, including the safety and health of all diving personnel. The appointed Dive Supervisor is to ensure that safety is never compromised to achieve a task. The Person-in Charge will have the final authority concerning diving operations; will exercise caution when dealing with matters not established by Company policy, and this decision will prevail. All Diving operations are conducted from a safe and suitable location on the surface to ensure all systems and equipment for safe diving operations have been provided and are in use.

The Supervisor is present at the dive location with the qualified personnel required to properly and safely conduct the dive and operate necessary equipment while diving operations are being conducted.

To ensure that a proper of Record of Dive reflecting depth, bottom time, and the decompression profile (including breathing gas changes) is maintained at the dive site, and that each diver reviews and signs this sheet after the completed of each dive.

Must be willing to submit to a drug screening.

GENERAL REQUIREMENTS

- Must have completed an additional 100 field days participating in commercial diving operations during which you shall have: Performed at least 50 working dives and performed a minimum of 30 days as an Assistant Surface-Supplied Air Diving Supervisor.
- Must be able to provide suitable recommendations.

EDUCATION REQUIREMENTS

- Must be a graduate of Commercial Dive School.
- Must possess ADC certification. (IMCA certification a plus)
- Any additional certifications such as OSHA training certificate a must.
- IMCA Approved Diver Medic or HSE First Aid at Work Certificate.
- HSE Part II or equivalent certificate.
